As we see more and more States order the Shut Down of all Non-Essential Businesses. It looks like the trend will be Service, Parts, and Body Shops will be permitted to remain open. I ask that you follow the direction of your State and Local Auto Dealers Association as it relates to your particular State. What to do if your dealership is Shut down?

Under a franchise agreement, a shutdown may be defined as a default under certain circumstances. However, if you are mandated by the government to close your doors, that is not something the manufacturer should be able to depend on for action against a dealership. However, you must still inform your manufacturer. (Do not assume they already know)

If you voluntarily shut down department(s) or your store(s) because of COVID-19 or its effects- for instance, if there is an outbreak of COVID-19 at the dealership- please notify your OEM right away. Tell them you have taken that step, so that they know the circumstances and the reason your business is temporarily closed. You must keep your manufacturer informed on any voluntary action(s).
